

Notice of Location "Crescent No 2" Mine.

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned a citizen of the United States over the age of twenty-one years on the 14th day of July 1898 discovered a vein or lode of Quartz, or sand rock in place bearing Copper, Gold, Silver and Lead, within the limits of the Claim hereby located, and have this 5th day of August 1898 under and in accordance with the Revised Statutes of the United States, located fifteen hundred linear feet of this vein or lode in length, with surface ground three hundred feet in width on each side of the center of said lode, situated in the Copper Creek Mining District County of Skamania and State of Washington and known as the Crescent No 2. Mining Claim and extending fifteen hundred feet to and from this notice at the discovery or prospect shaft; the exterior boundaries of this claim being distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or prominent monuments and more particularly described as follows, to-wit: 1000 feet east of Venus Mine on East Fork of Lewis River. Commencing at this notice of Location, which is posted at a point above where vein was discovered being the North end Center stake. Thence 1500 linear feet south westerly to a point being the South end Center Stake. Thence South westerly 300 feet to a point being the Southwest Corner stake. Thence North westerly 1500 feet to a point being the North west Corner Stake. Thence North easterly 300 feet to place of beginning. Thence North easterly 300 feet to a point being the Northeast Corner stake. Thence North easterly 1500 ft to a point being the South east Corner stake. Thence South westerly 300 ft to the South Center stake. This claim is bounded on the North by mining Claim Crescent No 1. and that intend to hold and work said above described claim as provided by the local laws and the Customs and rules of miners and mining statutes and laws of the United States
