HOMESTEAD CERTIFICATE NO. 954.

Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Vancouver Washington Territory whereby it appears that pursuant to an Act of Congress approved 20th May 1862 To Secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain ~~in conformity with law~~ and the act supplemental thereto the claim of Lorenzo Hill has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the South East quarter of the South West quarter and the South West quarter of the South East quarter of section eighteen in Township two North of Range Five East of Willamette Meridian in Washington Territory containing Eighty acres according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said Land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General. Now know ye, that there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Lorenzo Hill the tract of land above described: To have and to hold the said tract of land with the appurtenances thereof unto the said Lorenzo Hill and to his heirs, and assigns forever, subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing or other purposes and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws and decisions of Courts and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted as provided by law. In testimony whereof, I, Chester A. Arthur President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed Given under my hand at the City of Washington the Thirteenth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty three and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and eighth.

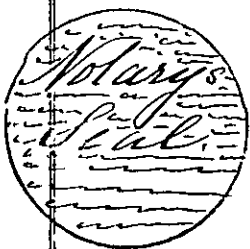
