Notice is hereby given that L. P. Grout of Skamania County, Washington, claims a lien upon a quantity of saw-logs being about 295,990 feet in quantity, which were cut and manufactured in Skamania County, Washington, of which approximately 150,000 feet are marked with the brand "G" and the balance are unmarked, and which are lying in the Columbia River in the eddy at and near the Ferry Dock at Stevenson, part of said logs being rafted

in two separate rafts, and the balance being loose in a bag or floating boom; said lien is claimed for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in cutting, logging and hauling said logs; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is J. A. Gilkinson; that he employed the said claimant to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

Upon a written agreement to log all merchantable timber upon SE $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. 12 tp. 3 N. R. 7 E. W. M. for the sum of \$4.50 per thousand feet, and hauling the same to the Columbia River for the sum of \$3.25 per thousand feet, under which said contract claimant so logged and hauled to the Columbia River 19,242 feet of logs;

Upon written agreement to log all merchantable timber upon the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. 24 tp. 3 N. R. 7 E. W. M. for the sum of \$3.75 and to haul the same to the Columbia River for the further sum of \$2.00 per thousand, which said contract was thereafter modified by a verbal agreement whereby the said claimant was to receive an additional sum of \$.25 per thousand feet in consideration of hauling said logs to a gravel road with caterpillar tractor, making the total sum to be received by claimant for logging and hauling the sum of \$6.00 per thousand feet; that pursuant to said agreement claimant so logged and hauled from said tract of land 126,748 feet of logs.

That said contract was faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said L. P. Grout, until claimant was notified by the officials of Skamania County to cease cutting and hauling said timber until the taxes levied against said real property are paid, and until claimant was prevented from further complying therewith by reason of the failure of said J. A. Gilkinson to comply with the terms of his agreement with claimant;

That claimant performed said labor and assistance in logging and hauling said logs for a period of 94 days, and that said labor and assistance was so performed and rendered upon said logs between the 19th day of February 1931 and the 24th day of May 1931, and the rendition of said services was closed on the 24th day of May 1931, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's claim for said services is \$2072.10; that no part thereof has been paid and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon the said sum of \$2072.10; after deducting all just debts and offsets, in which amount the said L. P. Grout claims a lien on all said saw logs and also all saw logs in said county owned by said J. A. Gilkinson to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing said logs herein described.
