

Notice of Location of "Skye" Mine

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned a citizen of the United States, over the age of twenty-one years on the 26th day of June 1897 discovered a vein or lode of Quartz, or sand rock in place bearing Gold, Silver, and Lead, within the limits of the claim hereby located, and have this 28th day of June 1897 under and in accordance with the General Statutes of the United States located fifteen hundred linear feet, of this vein or lode in length, with surface ground, three hundred feet in width on each side of the center of said lode situated in the Bald Mountain district Mining District County of State of Wash. and County of Skamania and known as the "Skye" Mine Mining Claim, and extending fifteen hundred feet to each from this notice at the discovery or prospect shaft: the exterior boundaries of this claim being distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or prominent corner marks, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

This claim is at on Blue Bird trail on the north and 1150 feet South Westward from the North West corner post section 33 Town 8 North East, one at discovery or shaft thence 300 feet in a north east by corner to corner post No 2 thence 1500 feet North East by corner to corner post No 3, thence 300 feet in a South West by corner to corner and post No 4, thence 300 feet South West by corner to corner post No 5 thence 1500 feet in a South West by corner to corner post No 6 thence 300 feet North East to place of beginning and that

in kind to hold and work said above described claim as provided by laws, and the local laws and the customs and rules of mines and mining statutes and laws of the United States discovered on the ground.
