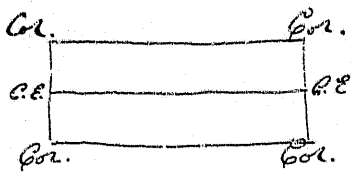


Moonlight Claim. Bald Mountain Mining District.



Notice of Quartz Location

Washington State.

This diagram will explain Bald Mountain Mining District. method of description of claim.

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, having complied with the requirements of Chapter six, of Title thirty-two, of the revised Statutes of the United States, and the laws of the above State, and the local customs and regulations of said District, has located and does hereby locate 1500 linear feet on the Moonlight Lode situated in Skamania County, in the above State and Mining District, and further described as follows:

Commencing at a post marked South West Corner post at the South West corner, from thence 300 feet in a Northeasterly direction to a center end post marked West end center post, thence 280 feet in a South Easterly direction to a corner post marked South East corner post, thence 1280 feet in a South Westerly direction to a center end post marked East end center post, thence 300 feet in a South Westerly direction to a corner post marked South West corner post, thence 1500 feet to place of beginning, intending to claim fifteen hundred linear feet in length and five hundred & eighty feet in width, for the purpose of mining the same, claiming all surface rights, privileges and minerals, and other rights granted by existing laws and customs. This claim is further described as follows: The East end of Moonlight Claim connects with the West end of the Starlight Claim and is on the same ledge as the Starlight and Rambler Claims, commencing at a point on the section line between sections 13 and 14, 200 feet south of the quarter stake thence in a direction 20 degrees north of West 2366 feet this point being the location of the east end center post of the Moonlight Claim, the Center line extending 1500 feet in the same direction with the north side 280 feet from center and South side line 300 feet from the center line and located in Section 14 T. 3 N. Range 5 East 13th.

Posts are placed at each corner and both ends of center line. This notice is placed at discovery.
