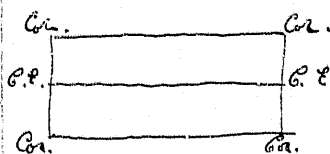


"Golden Eagle" Claim. Bald Mountain Mining District.

method of description of claim. Bald Mountain Mining District.

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, having complied with the requirements of Chapter six, of Title thirty-two, of the revised Statutes of the United States, and the laws of the above State, and the local customs and regulations of said District, has located and does hereby locate fifteen hundred linear feet on the Golden Eagle lode situated in Kamania County, in the above State and Mining District, and further described as follows: Commencing at a post marked corner post at the South West corner, from thence 275 feet in a Northeasterly direction to a center end post marked West End Center post, thence 300 feet in a North Easterly direction to a corner post marked North East Corner post, thence 1000 feet in a North Easterly direction to a corner post marked South East Corner, thence 300 feet in a South Westerly direction to a center end post marked East End Center post, thence 275 feet in a South Westerly direction to a corner post marked South West thence 1000 feet to place of beginning, intending to claim fifteen hundred linear feet in length and 575 linear feet in width, for the purpose of mining the same, claiming all surface rights, privileges and minerals, and other rights granted by existing laws and customs. This claim is further described as follows: The Golden Eagle Claim forms connection with the Order and Equality claims as shown in the accompanying plot and on the same ledge commencing at a point on the section line between Sections 14 and 13 980 feet North of the quarter stake thence running five and a half degrees North of West (variation of needle 19 degrees East of North) 630 feet, this point being the East end of the center line of the Golden Eagle claim and the center line end extending in the same direction 1000 feet and the side line on the South 275 from center line the opposite side 300 feet from center line. Posts are placed at each corner and both ends of center line. This notice is placed at discovery. Golden Eagle is located in the North East quarter of Sec 14 T. 36 N. Range 5 East. Will.
