NOTICE OF LIEN CLAIM.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That Southworth Hauling Co., a corporation, claims a lien upon a quantity of saw-logs, now lying in the Columbia River, and tributaries thereof, as herein after specified, being approximately 750,000 feet, as follows; approximately 350,000 feet marked with a crescent thus "(" which are tied up in the Columbia River in Clark County, Washington at a point about three miles east of the city of Vancouver, all of said logs being yellow fir; about 225,000 feet of red fir logs which are held in the slough or eddy near Skamania, in Skamania County, Washington, generally known as the "Butler Slough", being marked thus "H" about 150,000 feet of yellow fir logs held in said "Butler Slough" which are marked with a crescent thus "("; all of which said logs were cut or manufactured in Skamania County, Washington, That the name of the owner, or reputed owner Company. That the said claim is for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in obtaining, transporting and hauling said saw-logs, said work, labor and assistance consisting of constructing, repairing and maintaining roads over which said logs were hauled; and in hauling and transporting said logs from the place where the same were cut or manufactured to a dumping ground or place at and in the "Butler Slough" near Skamania, Skamania County, Washington.

That the said Beacon Rock Logging Company employed the said claimant to perform said labor and render such assistance in securing transporting and hauling said logs upon the

following terms and conditions, to-wit;

For surfacing that certain road known as the "Cuptell" road the said Beacon Rock Logging Company, promised and agreed to pay the claimant the sum of \$.72 per cu yd ^{for 308 cu yd} of rock placed thereon, and the sum of \$1.44 for 60 cu yd rock placed thereon; For surfacing and maintaining other roads, and hauling logs from the yarding places, (other than the Cuptell logs hereinafter mentioned) the sum of \$2.15 per thousand feet for all logs hauled; for hauling the "Cuptell" logs from the C S Cuptell property to said Butler Slough, the sum of \$1.50 per thousand feet; for hauling donkeys and other material and equipment, the sum of \$376.00.

That the said contract was faithfully performed by the claimant. That claimant surfaced said Cuptell road and hauled thereon the said 308 cu yd of rock at \$.72 per cu yd, and the said 60 cu yd at \$1.44 per cu yd, for which work the said Beacon Rock Logging Company became indebted to claimant in the total sum of \$308.16; that claimant surfaced other roads, and maintained the same pursuant to said agreement, and hauled a total of 1,587,547 feet of logs (exclusive of the Cuptell logs) at said agreed price of \$2.15 per thousand feet, for which said Beacon Rock Logging Company became indebted to claimant in the total sum of \$3,415.23; That claimant hauled 229,181 feet of logs from the Cuptell place as above mentioned, at \$1.50 per thousand feet, for which the said Beacon Rock Logging Company became indebted to claimant in the total sum of \$343.77. That claimant did other miscellaneous hauling in transporting donkey and other logging equipment and machinery which said services were of the reasonable value of \$376.00, and for which the said Beacon Rock Logging Company became indebted to claimant in the said sum of \$376.00.

That the claimant commenced to perform said labor and render said assistance on the 18th day of December 1931 and continued until the 19th day of May 1932, a period of five months and one day, and the rendition of said services ceased on the said 19th day of May 1932, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time;

That the total amount of claimant's claim and demand for said services is \$4,441.16; that no part thereof has been paid except the sum of \$2,415.21 and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$2,025.95, in which amount the said claimant claims a lien on all of said saw-logs.

That said Southworth Hauling Co., also claims a lien on all said saw-logs now owned by said Beacon Rock Logging Company cut and manufactured in said county to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining and securing the said logs herein described,
