

Notice of Location "Eugene" mining claim

To whom it may concern:

Notice is hereby given, That M. J. Parham and Mrs. Ada Renemore citizens of the United States of America over the age of twenty-one years having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-two, of the Revised Statutes of the United States, and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the State of Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners did on the 24th day of June A. D. 1898 locate, and by this notice do hereby locate a Lode Claim known as the Eugene Lode or mining claim, said claim having been discovered the 21st day of June 1898 and do claim (fifteen hundred linear feet on this lead, lode or vein bearing mineral in place, by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs and angles and all other veins or lodes the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries) (twenty acres of placer mining ground) situated in Copper Creek Min. District County of Klamath State of Washington said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows to-wit:

Situated in Texas Gulch on the West side about 200 yards south of an old abandoned shaft, & joins the North Star claim on the West side. Beginning at this notice or place of discovery and running 300 feet in a North westerly direction to N. W. corner.

Thence 1500 ft in a South Westerly direction to P. H. corner. Thence 600 feet in South easterly direction to S. E. corner. Thence 1500 ft in a North easterly direction to N. E. corner. Thence 300 ft in a North Westerly direction to location notice or place of discovery. And we intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and the mining laws of the United States and of the State of Washington.
