

"Anneck" Claim. Copper Creek Mining District.

Notice of Location of Lurey Claim.

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, a citizen of the United States, over the age of twenty-one years, on the 10 day of Sept 1899, discovered a vein or lode of Lurey or sand rock in place bearing Gold, Silver and Lead, within the limits of the claim hereby located, and have this 15 day of Sept 1899, under and in accordance with the Revised Statutes of the United States, located fifteen hundred linear feet of this vein or lode in length, with surface ground three hundred feet in width on each side of the center of said lode situated in the Copper Creek mining District, County of Skamania and State of Washington and known as the Anneck mining Claim, and extending fifteen hundred feet to and from this notice at the discovery or prospect shaft; the exterior boundaries of this claim being distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at Notice & running 1000 ft E. N. E. to N. W. corner. Hence 1000 ft South of S. W. to S. W. corner. Hence 600 ft S.E. to S. E. corner. Hence 1500 ft North of N. E. to N. E. corner. Hence 1000 ft to ledge & Notice.

Said claim is in Sec 25 Township 4 North of range 5 East & joins the creek on the South East end & the North Pacific on the North side & is on the West side of Texas gulch & about 1½ mile West of Lookout Mountain, also where the trail crosses Texas gulch & about 600 ft below Maiden gulch where it empties into Texas Creek.
