Iman of Skamania County Washington Territory notification No. 838 <sup>name</sup> Page 167. has been established to a donation of one half section or three hundred and twenty acres of land and that the same has been surveyed and designated as claim number forty four being parts of Sections two and eleven in Township two North of Range Seven East according to the Official Plat of survey returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General being bounded and described as follows to-wit: Beginning at the North East corner of said Section two and running thence South twenty three chains and twenty links thence West twenty chains and fifty links thence south seventy chains and fifty links thence North fifty four degrees and thirty minutes West forty one chains and twenty five links; thence North seventy-one chains fifty seven links and thence East fifty four chains to the place of beginning in the district of lands subject to sale at Vancouver Washington Territory containing three hundred and twenty three acres and twenty four hundredths of an acre. Now Know Ye that the United States of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the provisions of the Act aforesaid have given and Granted and by these presents Do give and Grant unto the said Felix <sup>name</sup> Iman and to his heirs the North half and unto his wife the said Margaret W. Iman and to her heirs the South half of the tract of land above described. To have and to hold the said tract with the appurtenances unto the said Felix <sup>name</sup> Iman and his wife Margaret W. Iman and to their heirs and assigns forever their respective portions as aforesaid. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said premises with their appurtenances unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever and the said party of the first part does hereby <sup>covenant</sup> ~~consent~~ to and with the said <sup>name</sup> party of the second part his heirs and assigns that she is the owner in fee simple of said premises that they are free from all incumbrances and that she will Warrant and Defend the same from all lawful claims whatsoever.

The United States to David K. Ordway.

The United States of America, To all to whom these presents shall come Greeting:

Whereas, There has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Vancouver, Washington whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May 1862 "To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of David K. Ordway has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the East half of the South West quarter, the North West quarter of the South West quarter, and the South East quarter of the North West quarter of Section thirteen, in Township three North of Range Nine East of Willamette Meridian, in Washington, Containing one hundred and sixty acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:

Now Know Ye, That there is, therefore, granted by the United States unto the said David K. Ordway, the Tract of Land above described: To have and to hold the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said David K. Ordway, and to his heirs and assigns forever: subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local Customs, laws, and decisions of Courts, and also subject to the right of proprietor of a vein or lode, to extract and remove his ore therefrom should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law. And there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.
