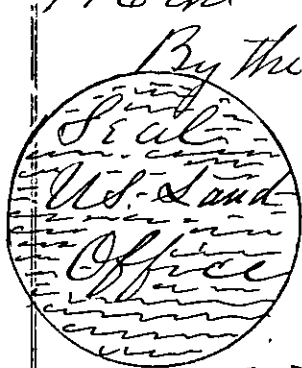

The United States to Caleb J. Moore.

The United States of America. To all to whom
 these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, there has been deposited in the General
 Land Office at Vancouver, Washington, whereby it
 appears that pursuant to "Act of Congress Appro-
 ved 20th May, 1862 To secure Homesteads to actual
 settlers on the Public Domain" and the acts supplé-
 mental thereto, the claim of Caleb J. Moore has been
 established and duly consummated in conform-
 ity to law, for the South West quarter of Section
 Seventeen in Township one North of Range five East
 of Willamette Meridian in Washington containing
 one hundred and sixty acres, according to the Offi-
 cial Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned
 to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:

Now know ye that there is, therefore, granted
 by the United States unto the said Caleb J. Moore
 the tract of Land above described: To have and
 to hold the said Tract of Land, with the appurtenances
 thereof, unto the said Caleb J. Moore and to his heirs
 and assigns forever: subject to any vested and accrued
 water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing
 or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs
 used in connection with such water rights, as may
 be recognized and acknowledged by local customs
 laws and decisions of courts, and also any
