Location Notice.

Notice is hereby given, That the undersigned, in compliance with the requirements of the Revised Statutes of the United States have this day located and claim fifteen hundred feet along the course of this lead, lode or vein of mineral bearing quartz and three hundred feet in width on each side of the middle of said lead, lode or vein, together with all mineral deposits contained therein and all timber growing within the limits of said claim, all water and water privileges thereon or appurtenant thereto, situate in the St. Helens Mining District, in the County of Skamania, Wash. and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:
