The Undersigned, who are citizens of the United States or
--- intention to become such citizen, Hereby Declare
and Give Notice to All Persons Concerned, that they have discover-
ed a vein or lode within the limits of the claim hereby locat-
ed, and in said lode a vein or crevice of quartz or ore,
with at least one well defined wall and that they have
this 16 day of September A.D. 1899, located and do hereby
locate and claim under and by virtue of Chapter Six of
Title Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States,
and the Laws amendatory thereto, and the laws of the State
of Washington, a Mining Claim upon said Lode or Vein, to be
designated and named the Octavia Quartz Lode Mining
Claim; extending along said vein or lode 1500 linear feet
in a North Westerly direction from the center of the Discovery
Shaft (at which shaft this notice and statement is posted) and
300 feet on each side from the middle or center of said lode
or vein at the surface; with all the rights and privileges, as
to surface ground and lodes, veins or ledges, within the bound-
aries of said claim, and otherwise, and the metals, minerals and
valuable deposits of every kind contained in said lodes, veins
or ledges, or within said boundaries, which are given or allow-
ed by the laws of the United States aforesaid, or of the State
of Washington.

This Location is distinctly marked on the ground, so that
its boundaries can readily be traced by a line, where this notice
and statement is posted this 16 day of September A.D. 1899, and
by substantial posts or monuments of stone at each corner of the
claim. And the exterior boundaries of the claim as marked
by said posts or monuments, and all side lines blazed on trees

beginning at discovery on the North Fork of the Toutle
River about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile from the beginning and at the
foot of a small cascade which is part of a large cascade at
the top of which is the discovery of the Copper Mary claim and
about 300 feet below the Elizabeth Mining Claim and about
one half a mile below the Juniper Mine claim and about

a quarter of a mile above the separation of the Spirit Lake and Lewis River trails and extending 1500 feet in a North Westerly direction 18° W of N.

The Mining Claim hereby located is situated in St. Helens Mining District Skamania County, State of Washington and is 1500 feet in length & 300 feet in width a relocation of the Octavia Mine located July 13, 1894.

The adjoining Claims are Esther Mary which it crosses and the Copley claim on the South and the North West Chicago Extension on the North.
