That the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Five dollars, to him in hand paid by the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted, bargained, sold, remised, released, unto the said party of the second part his heirs ~~executors~~ and assigns, the undivided one third interest in the "Tough Nut Lode," as located Surveyed and recorded and held by the said party of the first part, situated in Texas Mining District, Skamania County, State of Washington together with all the metals, ores gold and silver bearing quartz rock and earth therein, and all the rights, privileges thereto incident, or in anywise appertaining. He Have and to hold the said premises, together with the appurtenances thereto belonging, to the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever.

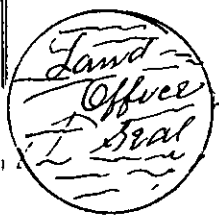
