

That claimant should receive the sum of two dollars per eight hour day, board and lodging to be furnished by the said owners upon consideration of work and assistance to be rendered by claimant's wife in cooking and assisting in the boarding house, claimant to do felling and bucking and other similar work in the woods.

That said contract was faithfully performed by claimant, and said work and assistance rendered by claimant's wife; that claimant performed work and rendered such assistance in cutting and manufacturing said saw logs for a period of thirty two days; that such labor and assistance was performed upon said saw logs between the 27th day of May 1933 and the 30th day of June, 1933 and the rendition of said services was closed on the 30th day of June, 1933, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time.

That the amount of claimant's demand for said services is the sum of \$64.00 and no part thereof has been paid excepting the sum of \$16.00 and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon the sum of \$48.00 in which amount he claims a lien upon said saw logs. That said Ancel Hitchman also claims a lien on all said saw-logs now owned by said A. C. Hitchman and Earl Hitchman in said county to secure payment for said work and labor performed in obtaining said saw logs herein described.
