THE UNITED STATES to HENRY GUNTHER.  
THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

To all to whom these presents shall come Greeting:

Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Vancouver, Washington territory, whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress, approved 20th day of May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the Acts Supplemental thereto, the claim of Henry Gunther has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the South West Quarter of Section two in Township one North of Range five East of Willamette Meridian in Washington Territory. Containing one hundred and sixty acres according to the official Plat of the Survey of said Land, returned to the General Land office by the Surveyor General.

Now Know Ye. That there is, therefore granted by the United States unto the said Henry Gunther the Tract of Land above described. To have and to Hold the said premises tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Henry Gunther, and to his heirs and assigns forever; subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural manufacturing or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs and laws decisions of Courts, and also subject to the right if the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law.

IN Testimony Whereof I Grover Cleveland President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand, at the City of Washington, the twenty-ninth day of September in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty eight, and of the Independence of the United States the one hundredth and thirtieth.
