Notice is hereby given that L. A. Gade of Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon a car load of railroad ties, unmarked, being about 720 in number, which were manufactured in Skamania County, Washington, and are now loaded upon car on siding of S. P. & S. Railway, at Home Valley in said Skamania County, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in the manufacture of said ties; that the name of the owner, or reputed owner, is Lee East, doing business as East Lumber Company; that the said Lee East employed the said claimant to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

By and through his foreman, H. E. Callahan, from Nov. 7th to Nov. 20th inclusive, at the wage of 42½¢ per hour, during which time he worked a total of 82½ hours; thereafter at the rate of 35¢ per thousand feet until Dec. 13, 1933, during which time there was produced a total of 67,158 feet, for which he was to receive the sum of \$23.50. Also for piling ties from ditch for which he was to receive the sum of \$1.00.
