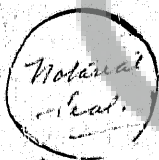
Before me personally appeared Douglas Caples, who being duly sworn says: That at least three hundred dollars (\$300.) worth of labor or improvements were performed or made upon the Blue Jacket, Kickapoo, and Dewey quartz mining claims. (contiguous) said expenditure or labor being for the benefit of the said three claims jointly, and consisting of 14 ft. of tunnel and 50 feet of new timbering, on Blue Jacket mine, and ten feet of shaft with excavation for machinery for sinking purposes on Kickapoo mine.

Said expenditure was made by or at the expense of E. L. Canby, L. M. Widdow, J. N. Covert, T. W. White, E. M. Cox, and D. Caples, owners of said claims, during the year 1899.

Also \$300 worth of labor and improvements on "Blue Bird", "Boodle" and Addenda No. 1 quartz claims (contiguous) said expenditure being for the development of the three said claims jointly, and consisting of 18 feet of tunnel on Blue Bird claim, and clearing and stripping 20 feet of ledge on Addenda No. 1. Expense of supplies and packing, and 14 days work on trail up Washougal river to said mines, said expenditure was made by or at the expense of S. P. White, E. M. Cox and D. Caples, owners of said claims during the year ending Dec. 31st 1899.
