in Cconnection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws and decisions of Courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom, shhuld the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law.
