

Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the land Office at Vancouver, Washington Territory whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the Public Domain", and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of William H. Enos has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the North West Quarter of Section Twenty-eight in Township Two North of Range Five East of Willamette Meridian, in Washington Territory, containing one hundred and sixty acres, according to the official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General.

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NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore, granted by the United States unto the said William H. Enos, the tract of Land above described.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said William H. Enos and to his heirs and assigns forever; subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in Connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and decisions of Courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom, should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I, Grover Cleveland President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.


DAVID WHITNEY JR. & WIFE TO JAMES A. REMICK (TRUSTEE)

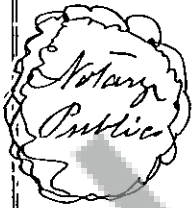
