Affidavit of work on "Morton" Mining Claim.

I, D. J. Lawton, being first duly sworn, say that at least One hundred dollars worth of labor and improvements were performed and made upon the "Morton" Mining Claim on the Rustler Lake Lake in the Bald Mountain Mining District in the County of Okanogan and State of Washington, during the year ending December 31, 1899. That such labor and improvements consisted of making dam and erecting saw mill on the "Dwight" claim; making fifty feet of open cut and 25 feet of tunnel on the "Spicer" and making sixty feet of tunnel on the "Shell Rock" claim. That said dam and saw mill were made and erected and said cut and tunnels made for the purpose of working and developing the said "Morton" claim, the said "Spicer" "Shell Rock" and "Dwight" claims and the "Cloudsley" "Henry" "See Lion" "Columbia View" and other claims all of said claims being contiguous; that such expenditure was made at the expense of the owners of said claim for the purpose of holding and developing said claim.
