Notice of Lien for Labor.

Robert Douglass, claimant, vs. J. W. Jeffries.

Notice is hereby given that Robert Douglass of Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon a quantity of logs and poles or piling, being about 165 logs and 109 poles or piling, which were cut or manufactured in Skamania County, Washington, are marked thus; the logs have a "J" on one end and an "O" on the other end and the poles or piling have a "J" on the end of some and others are unmarked, and the logs are now in the Story Boom on the Columbia River at Cocks, said County and State and the poles or piling are now in the Jessup Boom in Drano Lake at Cocks in said County and State, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in falling, bucking, loading, hauling, rafting and other services in connection with said logs, poles and piling;

That the name of the owner or reputed owner is J. W. Jeffries; that said J. W. Jeffries employed said Robert Douglass to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

The said J. W. Jeffries agreed to pay the said Robert Douglass 85 cts. per h. feet for the logs in the water and 3/4 of a cent per foot for the poles or piling and \$3.50 per day for day labor for 23 days; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of the said Robert Douglass who performed labor upon and assisted in procuring said logs, poles and piling as herein stated for the period of from May 4th, 1934 and July 20th, 1934, inclusive; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said logs, poles and piling between the 3rd day of May, 1934 and the 21st day of July, 1934; and the rendition of said services was closed on the 20th day of July 1934 and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimants demand for said service is \$134.37; that no part thereof has been paid except about \$31.00 and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$103.37, in which amount he claims a lien upon said logs, poles and piling. E.
