Affidavit of Assessment Work on "Skye" Mining Claim.

I, D. J. Lawton, being first duly sworn, say that at least one hundred dollars' worth of labor and improvements were performed and made upon the Skye Mining Claim on the Lash Chance Lode in the Bald Mountain Mining District in the County of Okanogan and State of Washington during the year ending December 31, 1899. That such labor and improvements consisted of making two hundred and seventy feet of tunnel upon the "Rounces" mining claim situated upon the same lode; that said tunnel was made for the benefit of and for the purpose of working and developing the said Skye claim, the said Rounces claim, and the July claim and the "16 to 1" claim, all of said claims being situated upon said Lash Chance lode and being contiguous; that such expenditure was made at the expense of the owners of said claim for the purpose of holding and developing said claim. That I have personal knowledge of all the above stated facts.
