THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, to whom these presents shall come Greeting: Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Vancouver, Washington, Territory, whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May 1862, "To Secure Homesteads to actual Settlers on the Public Domain", and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Peter Donnelly has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the south half of the South East quarter of section Six, in Township one North of Range Five East of Willamette Meridian, in Washington Territory, containing eighty acres, according to the official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:

KNOW YE KNOW: That there is, therefore Granted by the United States, unto the said Peter Donnelly and to his heirs and assigns forever; subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights as may be recognized and acknowledged by the Local customs, laws, and decisions of Courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove therefrom his ore, should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted as provided by law.

IN TESTIMONY whereof, I, Benjamin Harrison President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
