Affidavit of Assessment Work on "Fudge" Mining Claim.

I, D. J. Lawton, being first duly sworn, say that at least one hundred dollars' worth of labor and improvements were performed, and made upon the "Fudge" Mining Claim on the Last Chance Lode in the Bald Mountain Mining District in the County of Skamania and State of Washington during the year ending December 31, 1899.
