

Notice of Location of "Orphan Boy" mining claim

To whom it may concern: Olive H. H. H. H.

Notice is hereby given that the Elizabeth William Joseph William a citizen of the United States of America over twenty-one years, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof and of the State of Washington and the local customs laws rules and regulations of miners, did, on the first day of September A. D. 1896 locate and by this notice do hereby locate a Lode or mining Claim known as the "Orphan Boy" Lode or mining Claim said claim having been discovered the First of September 1898 and do claim (fifteen hundred linear feet on the claim land, lode, or vein bearing mineral in place by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs and angles and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries) (twenty acres of placer mining ground) situated in Hooksett Mt. Mining Dist County of Kamania State of Washington said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Corner ending at this stake and notice running 400 feet, Four hundred linear feet in a Northwesterly direction to a blazed tree, thence 800 feet Eight hundred linear feet in a Westerly direction to the Center end stake or Post, thence 300 ft Three hundred linear feet from stake in a North-easterly direction to Center end stake or Post, thence 300 ft Three hundred linear feet in a North Easterly direction along the Lode mine to the North East corner stake or Post thence 1500 ft Fifteen hundred linear feet in a Northwesterly direction with angles to the North-east corner stake or Post, thence 300 ft Three hundred linear feet in a Southerly direction to Center end

Stake or Post, thence 300 ft. Three hundred feet in a South Easterly direction to South West Corner post or Stake, thence 1500 ft. Fifty hundred feet with angles to the South East Corner Stake or Post, thence 300 ft. Three hundred feet along the Lile mine to the Center end stake or Post to the place of beginning.

And we intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and the Mining Laws of the United States and of the State of Washington.
