JOHN W BOSCHE TO MARY E. WAY.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That John W. Bosche (unmarried) of Tacoma, Territory of Washington, in consideration of Six Hundred Dollars to me paid by Mary E. Way, of Multnomah County, State of Oregon, have bargained and sold, and by these presents, do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Mary, E. Way, and unto her heirs and assigns, all the following bounded and described real property, situated in the County of Skamania and Territory of Washington, to-wit: - Lots Three (3) Four (4) and Five (5) and the South East quarter of Township Three (3) North of Range Six (6) the North West quarter of Section Six (6) East of the Willamette Meridian, containing 145.77/100 acres, as shown by the Final receipt No. 3312, from the Receiver of the Land Office at Vancouver, Territory of Washington:

Together with all and singular the tenements hereditaments, and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, and also all my estate, right, title and interest in and to the same, including dower and claim of dower.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described and granted premises unto the said Mary E. Way her heirs and assigns forever. And John W. Bosche, grantor above named does covenant to and with Mary E. Way the above named grantee, her heirs and assigns that the above granted premises are free from all incumbrances, except a mortgage executed by Grantor to Will. S. Cress July, 31, 1889 for \$525.00 with interest from date, at ten per cent, which is to be paid by the said Mary E. Way, and that he will, and his heirs, executors and administrators, shall warrant and forever defend the above granted premises, and every part and parcel thereof, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever, except said mortgage, which which the said Mary E. Way hereby agrees to pay.
