That the Carson Creek Logging Company is the owner or reputed owner of said timber lands, logging equipment, and other apparatus used in connection with the logging operation.

That the claimant ceased to perform work and labor on the 6th day of September 1934; that he worked approximately 80 days at the agreed amount of \$4.50 per day, earning a total amount of \$362.86 upon which he has paid a total of \$177.77 leaving a balance now due and owing of \$181.09; that the claimant claims a lien upon a certain quantity of saw logs, piling, and other timber now located upon the premises above described in Skamania County, Washington, and a lien upon all of the defendant's logging equipment, its right in a certain timber contract, its franchise, earnings, all of its real and personal property used in connection with the operation of its business to the extent of the money due from the said defendant to the claimant above named.

That 30 days have not elapsed since the cessation of the performance of the labor and the furnishing of the materials hereinabove mentioned; that there are no just credits or offsets to the knowledge of the lien claimant.
