Affidavit of Assessment Work on Dry Top Mining Claim.

I, D. J. Lawton, being first duly sworn, depose that at least one hundred dollars worth of labor and improvements were performed and made upon the Dry Top Mining Claim on the Yellow Jacket Lode, in the Bald Mountain Mining District in the County of Skamania and State of Washington during the year ending December 31, 1899. That such labor and improvements consisted of making sixty feet of tunnel upon the Shell Rock Mining Claim situated upon the same lode; that said tunnel was made for the benefit of and for the purpose of working and developing the said Dry Top claim, the said Shell Rock claim, and the Bald Mountain claim, all of said claims being situated upon said Yellow Jacket lode, and being contiguous; that such expenditure was made at the expense of the owners of said claim for the purpose of holding and developing said claim.
