THE U. States TO STEPHEN S. WAY.

CERTIFICATE NO. 3398.

The United States of America. To All to whom these presents shall come, GREETING:-

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WHEREAS: Stephen, S. Way of Multnomah County, Oregon, has deposited in the General Land Office of The United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Vancouver Washington Territory, hereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Stephen S. Way, according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" and the Acts supplemental thereto, for the South East quarter of Section Twenty, in Township three North, of Range six East of Willamette Meridian, in Washington Territory, Containing one Hundred and sixty acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said Tract has been purchased by the said Stephen S. Way.

KNOW NOW YE, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several "Acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have *and by these presents do give and grant* given and granted unto the said Stephen S. Way, and to his heirs and assigns, the Tract above described.

To Have and To Hold the same, together with all ~~and~~ the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Stephen S. Way and to his heirs and assigns forever; subject to any vested and accrued water right for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches used in connection with such water rights as may be recognized and acknowledged by the Local customs, laws and decisions of Courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom, should the same be found, to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law.

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In Testimony Whereof, I, Benjamin Harrison, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand, at the City of Washington, the Third day of April, in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Ninety-one, and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and Fifteenth.
