Affidavit of Assessment Work on Half Moon Mining Claim.

I, D. J. Lawton, being first duly sworn, say that at least one hundred dollars' worth of labor and improvements were performed and made upon the Half Moon Mining Claim on the Hoo Hoo Lode in the Bald Mountain Mining District in the County of Multnomah and State of Oregon during the year ending December 31, 1899. That such labor and improvements consisted of making 140 feet of tunnel upon the Little Hell Mining Claim situated upon the same lode; that said tunnel was made for the benefit of and for the purpose of working and developing the said Half Moon claim, the said Little Hell claim, and the Winona claim, all of said claims being situated upon said Hoo Hoo lode, and being contiguous; that such expenditure was made at the expense of the owners of said claim for the purpose of holding and developing said claim.
