Affidavit of Assessment Work on Winona Mining Claim.

I, D. J. Lawton, being first duly sworn to say that at least one hundred dollars worth of labor and improvements were performed and made upon the Winona Mining Claim on the Hoo Hoo Lode in the Bald Mountain Mining District in the County of Skamania and State of Washington during the year ending December 31, 1899.
