# NOTICE OF LIEN.

Said claim is for stumpage due to claimant for said logs and logs taken from claimant's property in Skamania County, Washington, within eight months previous to the filing of this lien. That the owners of said logs are Beacon Logging Company, a corporation, and/or R.H. Barr and J.D. Tennant.

That the said Beacon Rock Logging Company, a corporation, and R.H. Barr and J.D. Tennant cut and removed the said logs from claimant's property described as follows, to-wit:

That no part thereof has been paid and above named claimant claims a lien against the said logs and against the proceeds from the sale thereof in the sum of \$502.00.
