

THE U.S. TO CLINTON S. CRANSON.

THE United States of America,

To All To whom these presents Shall Come Greeting.

Whereas Clinton S. Cranson of Pierce County, Washington Territory, has ~~been~~ deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Vancouver, Washington Territory, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Clinton S. Cranson, according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820 entitled, "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands", and the Acts supplemental thereto, for the North East quarter, of Range Six East of Willamette Meridian, in Washington, Territory, containing one hundred and sixty acres according to the official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said Tract was purchased by the said Clinton S. Cranson.

Now Know Ye, that the United States of America in consideration of the premises, and in Conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Clinton S. Cranson and to his heirs, the said Tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Clinton S. Cranson, and the his heirs and assigns forever: Subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws and decisions of Courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom, should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law.

In Testimony Whereof, I, Benjamin Harrison President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and ^{the} ~~the~~ Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

confirm unto said party of the second party and to
his heirs and assigns forever, all of the following des-
cribed real estate, situated in Skamania County, Wash,
to wit: The North one half of the Northwest Quarter of
Section (17) seventeen in Township (1) one North, of Range
five (5) East of the Willamette Meridian, containing
eighty (80) acres, more or less, together with all and singular
the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances, belonging
or appertaining thereto, and also all our estate, right, title,
