NOTICE OF LIEN

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Francis Andring of Clark County, State of Washington,

claims a lien upon a quantity of saw logs, beabout 30,000 feet in cedar logs now located at the Carson Landing in the Columbia River in Skamania County, Washington, marked with the brand (V). Also about 100,000 feet fir logs marked with (V) the exact location of which is now known to claimant but he is informed and believes that the same were taken from Carson Landing, by Smith & Rosenback, towing contractors and that same are now at or near Hamilton Island in Skamania County, Washington. That the said saw logs were cut and manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington, and that claimant performed labor and rendered assistance in securing the same at the request of T. W. Finnegan for himself and as agent for the co-partnership of Barr and Finnegan upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit: That the said T.W.Finnegan promised and agreed to pay to claimant Sixty-five Cents (65¢) per hour for driving truck in transporting said logs and timber products and that the said claimant performed such labor and assistance in securing said logs for the period of 460 hours commencing on the 16th day of April, 1934, and that said labor and assistance was so rendered between the said 16th day of April, 1934, and the 19th day of October, 1934, and thirty (30) days have not elapsed since that time.

That the amount of claimant's demand for said service is the sum of Two Hundred and Ninety-nine and 00/100 (\$299.00) Dollars; that no part thereof has been paid excepting the sum of One Hundred Twenty and 93/100 (\$120.93) Dollars, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and off-sets, the sum One Hundred Seventy-eight and 07/100 (\$178.07) Dollars, for which amount claimant claims a lien upon the said saw logs and timber products. That the claimant also claims a line upon all said saw logs and timber products now owned by the said Robert Barr and T.W.Finnegan, co-partners, in said county to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said logs and timber products herein described.
