Affidavit of Work on Portland Mining Claim.

I, D. J. Lawton, being first duly sworn, say that at least One hundred dollars' worth of labor and improvements were performed and made upon the Portland Mining Claim on the Skamania lode in the Bald Mountain Mining District in the County of Skamania and State of Washington, during the year ending December 31, 1899. That such labor and improvements consisted of making 100 feet of tunnel upon the "Spruce" claim situated upon the same lode; that said tunnel was made for the purpose of working and developing said "Portland" claim and said "Spruce" claim and the "Chimney Rock" and "Height" claim, all of said claims being situated on the said Skamania lode and all of said claims being contiguous; that such expenditure was made at the expense of the owners of said claim for the purpose of holding and developing said claim.
