## NOTICE OF CLAIM OF LIEN

Notice is hereby given that FRANCIS ANDRING, of Clark County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon a certain quantity of saw-logs being about one hundred thousand (100,000) board feet of red fir logs; said logs having been logged and out in Skamania County, Washington. These logs are now located in a boom off Ryan's Point in the Columbia River being about one-half a mile east of the Pearson Flying Field at Vancouver, in Clark County, Washington. The logs range in length from thirty (30) to fifty (50) feet and are marked with the brand (77).

That this certain lien is for labor performed upon the said logs by driving a truck which hauled the same from the place where they were logged in Skamania County, Washington, to the Columbia River where they were dumped; the name of the owners or reputed owners is T. W. Finnegan and Robert Barr Logging Company; that T.W. Finnegan employed the said Claimant, Francis Andring to perform such labor and render such assistance by the operation of a logging truck and that the reasonable value of the services rendered by said Francis Andring is the sum of One Hundred Seventy-eight and 07/100 (\$178.07) Dollars, said labor and assistance was so performed and rendered between the 16th day of April, 1934 and the 20th day of October, 1934, and that the rendition of said services was closed on the 20th day of October 1934, and that thirty (30) days has not elapsed since that time and that the amount claimant demands for said services as aforesaid is One Hundred Seventy-Eight and 07/100 (\$178.07) Dollars; that no part thereof has been paid.

That said Francis Andring also claims a lien on all saw-logs now owned by said T.W. Finnegan and Robert Barr Logging Company in said county to secure work and labor performed in the hauling of said saw-logs herein described.
