Notice of Lien Claim

vs

Frank Birkenfeld,

Notice is hereby given that C. W. Hazard of Stevenson, Skamania County, Washington,

claims a lien upon a quantity of piling, being about 800 sticks of piling, which were cut or manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington, and are now in the Columbia River at the end of the road leading from the Home Valley Depot of the S. P. & S. Ry. Co to the said River, and in front of the land owned or occupied by said Frank Birkenfeld; that said claim is for work and labor performed and assistance rendered in procuring and transporting said piling; that the name of the owner, or reputed owner is Frank Birkenfeld.

The said claimant was employed by the said Frank Birkenfeld to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

That the said Frank Birkenfeld employed claimant to haul gravel for the construction of logging roads over which said piling was to be removed and for use in connection with the logging operations of said Frank Birkenfeld for which he agreed to pay claimant the sum of seventy cents (70¢) per cu yard for coarse rock hauled from pit known as Hadley pit and from Sepsecan, and the sum of sixty cents (60¢) per cu yd for fine gravel hauled from the Wind Mountain pit. That claimant faithfully complied with the terms of said agreement and in accordance therewith did haul 150 cu yards of coarse gravel from the Hadley pit, 12 cu yds from Sepsecan, and 228 yards of fine gravel from the Wind Mountain pit, all of which was properly placed upon said logging road.

That claimant commenced the performance of said work and labor and the hauling of said gravel on the 24th day of October, 1934 and continued to perform the same for a period of 34 days, ending on the 28th day of November, 1934, and the completion of said work and labor and hauling was on the said 28th day of November 1934, and 30 days have not elapsed since said time. That the amount of claimant's demand for said services is the sum of \$250.20; that no part thereof has been paid excepting the sum of \$59.73 and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$190.47, in which amount he claims a lien upon said piling.

That the said C. W. Hazard also claims a lien upon all said piling, saw logs and other timber products now owned by said Frank Birkenfeld in said county to secure the payment for the work and labor performed by claimant in securing the said piling and saw logs and other timber products.
