ISAAC THOMAS & MARY DRYMAN

TO WILLIAM BUTTER.

THIS INDENTURE made this 17th day of August in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and ninety-one. Witnesseth: That Isaac Thomas Mary Dryman, Edwin Thomas and Henry Thomas of Skamania County, Wash, parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred Dollars, money of the United States of America to us in hand paid by William Butter of Skamania County, Washington, party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell, alien, remise, release, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns ^{forever} all of the following described real estate, situated in Skamania County, Washington, to-wit:-

The West half of what is known as the Dryman Land, the same being a part of that piece or parcel of land deeded and conveyed by H. A. & Pluma Leavans, husband and wife to John Dryman, deceased on the 8th day of April, A.D. 1878, and situated in Section Thirty-five (35) Township two (2) North of Range Six (6) East, and containing ten (10.31/100) thirty one hundredths acres, For more particular description, reference is here made to Skamania County Records of Deeds Book "C" page 12.

Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances, be-
^{longing} ~~for appertaining~~ thereto, and also all our estate, right, title, interest, possession, claim of dower and Homestead; and the rents, issues and profits of, in, and to said real estate. To have and to hold the same to the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever. And the said parties, of the first part do covenant with the said party of the second part, that the said real estate is free, from all encumbrances, and that we will, and our heirs, executors and administrators, shall warrant and defend the same to the said party of the second part, and to his heirs, and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whatsoever.
