WHEREAS: William F. Lamson of Pierce County Washington, Territory has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a Certificate of the Register of the Land office at Vancouver, Washington, Territory, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said William F. Lamson according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled, "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" and the Acts supplemental thereto, for the North West quarter of Section eight in Township two (2) north of Range Six East of Willamette Meridian, in Washington Territory, containing one hundred and Sixty acres, according to the Plat of the survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office, by the Surveyor General, which said Tract has been purchased by the said William F. Lamson.

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Know now Ye, That the United States of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said William F. Lamson and to his heirs and assigns the said Tract above described; To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of what soever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said William F. Lamson, and to his heirs and assigns forever: Subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural manufacturing and reservoirs, used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws and decisions of Courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein of lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom, should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law,
