Landenberger, according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820, entitled, "An Act making further provision for the Sale of the Public Lands", and the Acts supplemental thereto, for the South East quarter of Section Thirty-two in Township Three North of Range Six East of Willamette Meridian, in Washington Territory, containing one hundred and sixty acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said Tract has been purchased by the said Christian A. Landenberger.
