Greeting:

Whereas, there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Vancouver Washington Territory, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To Secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the Public Domain, and the Acts supplemental thereto, the claim of William Floyd has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the East half of the South East quarter and the South half of the North East quarter of Section Thirty-four in Township Two North, of Range Five East of Willamette Meridian, in Washington Territory, containing one hundred and sixty acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office, by the Surveyor General.

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the United States, unto the said William Floyd, the Tract of Land above described: To have and To Hold the said Tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said William Floyd and to his heirs and assigns forever; subject to any vested or accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs laws, and decisions of Courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove the ore therefrom should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises here by granted as provided by law.

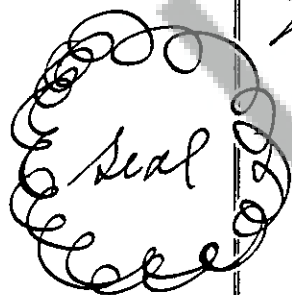
