We the undersigned citizens of the United States, having complied with all the requirements of the law claim all the water in the West Fork of the North Fork of the stream Washougal, for mining and milling purposes said stream running across the alluvial claims known as the Sunday Morning, Two Brothers and the Blue Jennie said claims being in section 29 and 30 T. 3. N. R. 5. E. of the W. M. County of Okanogan State of Washington, commencing at the South boundary line of the Sunday Morning, thence running up the bed of said stream one mile
