

"Astarke" claim. Copper Creek Mining District.

Notice of Location.

To whom it may concern—

Notice is hereby given that I, the undersigned, citizen of the United States; over the age of 21 years; having complied with the requirements of Chapter 6, of Title 22, of the Revised Statutes of the United States and the local mining laws, rules and customs, have located a Quartz Claim on this lode or vein, to be known as the "Astarke" Claim—extending 1500 linear feet along said lode or vein, situated in the "Copper Creek" Mining District, Skamania County, State of Washington and more particularly described as follows—Beginning at this location Notice on Larch Tree growing on the left bank of the stream called "Rolen" Creek and running E.N.E. 300 feet to Stake marked S.E. corner of "Astarke" Claim, thence N.W. 1500 feet to Stake marked N.E. corner of "Astarke" Claim, thence W.S.W. 300 feet to Stake marked N. Center of "Astarke" Claim, continuing 300 feet to large Fir Tree marked S.W. corner of "Astarke" claim, thence S.E. 1500 feet to Stake marked S.W. corner of "Astarke" Claim thence E.S.E. 300 feet to place of beginning.
