NOTICE OF LIEN.

Notice Is Hereby Given that on the 13th day of May, 1934 Henry Roe, hereinafter referred to as the "CLAIMANT" did at the Special instance of request of M.George Miller and Frank Birkenfeld commence to perform labor and assist in obtaining and securing saw logs, spars, piles and other timber and also furnished materials and tools which were used in the performance of the labor and in the obtaining and securing of saw logs, spars, piles and other timber, said labor being furnished and materials being furnished at the Logging operations of M. George Miller and Frank Birkenfeld at Home Valley in Skamania County, Washington.

That M. George Miller and Frank Birkenfeld are the owners or ^{the} reputed owners of timber lands, logging equipment and other apparatus in connection with the aforementioned logging operation, and in particular are the owners of One (1) Used Model "FM" Walter Four Point Positive Drive Truck No. FM 32 #344394 and one (1) Teco 8-Ton Model 8B-211 Logging Trailer.

That claimant ceased to perform work on the 19th day of May 1935; that he worked approximately 200 days at the agreed amount of \$5.00 per day earning a total of \$1051.00 upon which he has been paid the sum of \$225.00, leaving a balance due and now owing in the sum of \$826.00; that the claimant claims a lien upon all saw logs, piling, and other timber of Frank Birkenfeld now in Skamania County, Washington; and a lien upon all of the defendant's logging equipment, its right in timber contracts, their franchise, earnings, all their real and personal property used in connection with the operation of their business to the extent of the money now due from the said M. George Miller and Frank Birkenfeld.

That 30 days have not elapsed since the cessation of the performance of the labor and the furnishing of the materials hereinabove mentioned; that there are no just credits or offsets to the claim herein to the knowledge of the lien claimant.
