BY it appears that pursuant to an Act of Congress approved 20th of May 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the Public Domain and the Acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Albert C. Ussery has been established and duly consumated in conformity to law, for the South Half of the South East quarter of Section twelve in Township two North of Range Five East of Willamette Meridian, in Washington Terrotory, containing eighty acres, according to the official plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General.

Know Know Ye, that there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Albert C.Ussery the said Tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Albert C.Ussery and to his heirs and assigns forever; subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and decisions of courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove this ore therefrom, should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law.

In testimony whereof I, Chester A. Arthur President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Batent and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
