To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Vancouver, Washington Territory, whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, To secure homesteads to actual settlers on the Publ.ic.adomatn" and the acts supplemental, thereto the claim of August Lucke has been established and duly consumated, in conformity, to law, for the south half of the South West quarter of Section twelve in Township two North, of Range five East of Willamette Meridian, in Washington Territory, containing eighty acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the United States, unto the said August Lucke that ract of Land above described. Yo have and to hold the said Tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said August Lucke, and to his heirs and assigns forever; subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural manufacturing or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and decisions of courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a veib or lode to extract and remove him ore: therefrom, should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law.
