Notice is hereby given that A.L. Walker of Skamania County, Washington, claims a lien upon a certain quantity of saw logs said logs being 302 in number having no brand being maple and alder and hardwood logs which were cut in Skamania County, Washington, and are now lying in the Columbia River and on the Columbia River bank at a point commonly known and called Castle Rock about a mile and a half east of Butler in Skamania County, Washington, the said lien claimed being for labor performed and assistance rendered in hauling with his team said logs to bank of Columbia River at Castle Rock Washington, that the name of the owner of said logs or the reputed owner is George Ryahn that he employed this claimant A.L. Walker the sum of \$5.00 per day for himself and team that under said terms this claimant performed labor with himself and team in removing and hauling said logs above described to the bank of the Columbia River at said place, from and including May 6th to and including May 15th 1914, amounting in all to the sum of \$25.00 and that said labor was fully performed and that sum of \$25.00 is now due and owing claimant for said services performed from George Ryahn the owner or reputed owner thereof, and that he claims a lien on all of said logs owned by said George Ryahn in said County to secure payment for labor performed in hauling and delivering said logs to place above named.
