Cook of Ellettsworth in the same County & State My True & Lawful Attorney, for me and in my name place and stead, to enter into and take possession of all such mills lands tenements hereditaments & real estate whatever in the State of Washington to or in which I am or may be in any way entitled or interested: and to grant bargain and sell the same or any part thereof, for such sum or price and on such terms as to him shall seem meet; and for me and in my name to make, execute, acknowledge, and deliver good and sufficient deeds and conveyances for the same: either with or without covenants and warranty: and until the sale thereof, to let & demise the said mills & real estate for the best rent that can be procured for the same: and to ask, demand, collect, recover and receive, all sums of money which shall become due and owing to me, by means of such bargain and sale, or lease and demise giving and granting unto my said attorney, full power and authority to do and perform all and every act and thing, whatsoever, requisite and necessary to be done, in and about the premises, as fully to all intents and purposes, as I might or could do if personally present, with full power of substitution and revocation, hereby ratifying and confirming all that my said attorney, or his substitute, shall lawfully do, or cause to be done, by virtue thereof.
