UNITED STATES TO MARY HAFLEY

THE UNITED STATES of America.

To all to whom these presents Shall Come Greeting:

Whereas, Mary Haffey, of Skamania County, Washington Territory, has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Vancouver, Washington, Territory, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by Mary Haffey according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled, "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands", and the acts supplemental thereto, for the North West quarter of Section Ten, in Township two North of Range Five East of Willamette Meridian, in Washington Territory, containing one hundred and sixty acres according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which Tract has been purchased by the said Mary Haffey.

Now Know Me, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Mary Haffey, and to her heirs the said Tract, above designated and described, To have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Mary Haffey, and to her heirs and assigns, forever; subject to any vested water rights as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws and decisions of Courts, and also subject to the rights of the proprietor of a vein or lode to and remove his ore therefrom should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted as provided by law.

execution as may be sufficient to satisfy the claim  
of the said Merchants National Bank a Corporation  
plaintiff and if sufficient personal property be not  
found to satisfy the judgment aforesaid you are then  
commanded to levy on the real property of the said  
defendant or so much thereof as may be found in  
your County not exempt from execution sufficient to  
satisfy the judgment aforesaid with the additional  
costs herein and that you proceed forthwith to satisfy  
said judgment according to law; and of this writ make  
due and lawful service and return with your  
proceedings hereon. In Witness Whereof I have hereunto

Washington this 20<sup>th</sup> day of December AD 1893
